## Why do I need a VOC?

If a company you work for, or a work-site you are visiting, requests a current VOC for a specific piece of plant or to undertake a particular task, you will need to comply with the request in order to undertake the work.

## Do VOC's expire?

The industry standard for verification of competency re-assessment is typically biennial (every two years). As an RTO we do not govern or regulate your individual or organisational policies or procedures and the requirement for Verification of competency Assessment is set out by the employer, principal contractor, authority or PCBU. For this reason, we currently don't have expiry dates on the VOC's that we issue however the date of issue will be printed on the certificate or wallet card.

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
